Abstract Content:

Abstracts are invited across the dimensions of nursing practice; that is, administration, education, practice and research. Abstracts should include the title, purpose, conceptual frame work (if applicable) methodology/ strategy appropriate to type of submissions, results and discussion. Abstracts must be relevant to the conference title and objectives.
