Bioethics and Public Policy Report

November 2015

The National Scene: • Both the U.S. House of Representatives (H.R. 3301) and the U.S. Senate (S. 1881) have voted to defund <u>Planned Parenthood, Inc.</u>, due to the selling of fetal body parts from their abortions. • The U.S. House of Representatives also passed legislation giving states the choice to exclude abortion providers from their <u>Medicaid</u> programs.

The State of *Conscience/Religious Liberty*. It is a sad day when the government does not protect a nurse from being forced to harm human life. It is time for Congress to pass the Abortion Non-Discrimination Act. • NCBC has joined other organizations in response to U.S. Department of Health and Human Services proposed rule "Nondiscrimination in Health Programs and Activities," cautioning that it would likely "infringe upon the religious and moral convictions of health-care providers, insurers and other stakeholders." In fact, it would discriminate against persons of conscience who oppose abortion and other procedures that violate life and the dignity of human sexuality. • The Illinois Human Rights Commission has ruled against a bed and breakfast which refused to host a civil union ceremony between two men. • A Colorado baker has petitioned the State Supreme Court to hear his appeal of a lower court decision telling him he must provide cakes for same-sex weddings. • The American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU), et al, have filed suit against the Louisiana Governor's "Marriage and Conscience" executive order, which protects the religious freedom of those who hold that marriage is between one man and one woman. • The Alliance Defending Freedom has filed a federal lawsuit against the California Department of Managed Health Care for forcing churches to pay for elective abortions in their health insurance plans. • A California law requiring crisis pregnancy centers to inform women where to get an abortion is being challenged as a violation of freespeech. • The ACLU has sued Trinity Health Corporation for refusing to perform abortions on women whose babies were diagnosed with fatal fetal anomalies. • Also, see Recent Good News.

State *by State*: The United States Supreme Court has agreed to hear a challenge to a 2013 Texas law, HB2, that requires abortion facilities to meet minimum health and safety standards and that abortionists maintain hospital privileges within 30 miles of their abortion facilities. • The Governor of Texas has eliminated taxpayer funding of Planned Parenthood, after exposure of the sale of fetal parts. • A federal U.S. District Court judge has temporarily stayed the order of the Louisiana Governor to eliminate taxpayer funding of Planned Parenthood. A similar ruling was ordered against the state of Arkansas.

Recent *Good News*: The Clark County, NV, School District reversed its denial of freedom of speech to a student wanting to establish a Pro-life Club. The student was represented by the Thomas More Society. • The Nevada State Commission on Special Licenses Plates has approved the "Nevada Values Life" license plate. • Real Alternatives, a life-affirming alternative (to abortion) care model, has received 3.5 million dollars in funding from the State of Indiana. •
