		exposed to the danger of a limited interior piety only, dissociated from the profession and
		exterior practices enjoined by the Church. Furthermore, modern theories seek to penetrate the
		minds of Catholic nurses and to make them become unconsciously strong agents for the
		propagation of eugenics and neo-malthusianism. It is necessary, then, to protect them by
		means of Catholic Action, which has for one of its duties to sustain and fortify them in their
		professional and Christian formation."

		found to emphasize the necessity of bringing all Catholic nurses within the influence of Catholic
		Association of Nurses" and requested "In accordance with this wish of the Holy Father, It is most
		desirable, Your Excellency, that the Catholic nurses of the United States be gathered into one national
		association under the direction of the respective Ordinaries of the Hierarchy.""In keeping with the
